How to Enter

Please complete the entry form (one per person) and return the form(s) *in advance* by 3pm on15 September to the Horsley Village Shop or the Horsley School Reception. Please bring payment with your entries on 'Show Day'. Entries cost 20p per child or 50p per adult per entry. New forms and entries will still be welcome and accepted on the day of the Show, but please be aware that the 'late' entry fee will be 50p per child and £1 per adult entry.

11am-1pm	Judging takes place in private.	
1-5pm	Open for public viewing.	
3pm	Winners' Cups are awarded in the Main Arena.	
4-5pm	Collection of exhibits and prizes.	

Entry Rules

- Entries are open to anyone and everyone, from residents or those attending the school, to anyone who has simply been to Horsley, whether that be to visit the shop or playground or attended any of the previous fetes & celebrations. Everyone is very welcome to join the fun!
- Only one entry is allowed per person per class.
- *Adult* Prizes 1st, 2nd and 3rd place certificates.
- *Junior* Prizes 1st, 2nd and 3rd place rosettes.
- A *Winner's Cup* and a *Junior Winner's Cup* will be awarded to the *Adult* and to the *Junior* with the best overall entry or entries.
- Exhibits must be the creation of the exhibitor only and made within the last 5 years.
- Entries for categories A, B, and C must have been grown at home or on a local allotment by the person entering.
- Where classes call for more than one item (e.g. 3 tomatoes), the items should be as similar in size and appearance as possible. Plates will be provided to display your produce on the morning of the Show.
- Exhibits must not show the exhibitor's name anywhere. Exhibits will be displayed with a 'show card' which will be handed to you on the day.
- The decision of the judges is final.
- Organisers will not be responsible for the loss or damage of any exhibit.
- Any exhibits or prizes not collected by 5pm on the day of the show may be disposed of; consumables will be donated to The Long Table.
