



Full-time SEND 1:1 Teaching Assistant

Temporary contract for the duration of the time the pupils are in school

Do you want to make a difference to children's lives? Do you want to be part of a dynamic, 'all singing', 'all dancing' team of staff who love working with children? We are seeking to appoint a part-time Teaching Assistant to work with well-behaved children, with SEND needs.

The position combines 5 mornings as a Teaching Assistant supporting these children, with 1-hour daily MDSA duties (at an appropriate grade), and 5 afternoons.

Working as part of a small team requires a teaching assistant who is adaptable and able to work collaboratively with members of the school and wider community. The successful candidate will also need to support the school's distinctively Christian values (being a practising Christian is, however, not a prerequisite). We can offer you well-behaved and motivated pupils and a supportive (if slightly mad) team of staff, as well as parents and governors, who all share equally high expectations and aspirations for our children.
