Welcome back to school! I hope you all had a restful Easter break. As we go into the new term, please note the following:

### **May Day**

This year we are able to hold our annual traditional May Day celebrations. Due to the pandemic, for many of you, this will be a new experience - it is one of those special and unique Horsley traditions. In line with tradition, there will be an entrance of the May Queen and Jack in the Green. This will take place outside by the EYFS decking area. We will then proceed to Ruskin Mill for Country Dancing. The children will be provided with a complementary croissant and drink, courtesy of Ruskin Mil. Please bring your own snack if your child is allergic to croissants. If any local musicians would like to join us, please do come with your instruments as we process down to Ruskin Mill (music will be provided).
