Horsley Cycling and Walking Project Survey - Please help


A small group of local Horsley residents, with the support of the Parish Council, have got together to form the Horsley Cycling and Walking Project. The objective of the project is to support and encourage active travel to, from and around Horsley. We hope to achieve this by improving existing walking routes between Horsley, the surrounding Hamlets and Nailsworth and by supporting the provision of cycling facilities. We are putting together a funding bid for these improvements from Stroud District Council by the end of July.

To support the bid, and the work of the project more generally, we want to know more about how pupils (and their parents/carers) travel to and from Horsley CoE school in a typical week. We are therefore requesting that as many pupils as possible, with the help of a parent or carer, complete a short survey (it should take less than 5 mins).
