


If you have any green or yellow school uniform items, you would like to donate, Lizzy will be collecting them from outside the church after school during the last week of term.

### **ABOUT THE PROGRAMME**

Have a Go is an inclusive school holiday programme in association with Gloucestershire County Council HAF (Holiday Activities and Food programme) with the aim of providing young people in receipt of free school meals access to music-making activities. Lunch is provided daily for all those attending.

Through the four days, young people and children will gain experience learning through multiple music activities such as; Singing, Songwriting, Rapping, DJ'ing, Music Production and playing instruments, whilst having fun and making new friends. They will spend time learning how to set up/ use equipment as well as creating new music/songs, working as a team and collaborating with other young people.

Have a Go will not be running on Wednesday 9th or Wednesday 23rd August, instead our Music Bus will be in Kings Square
