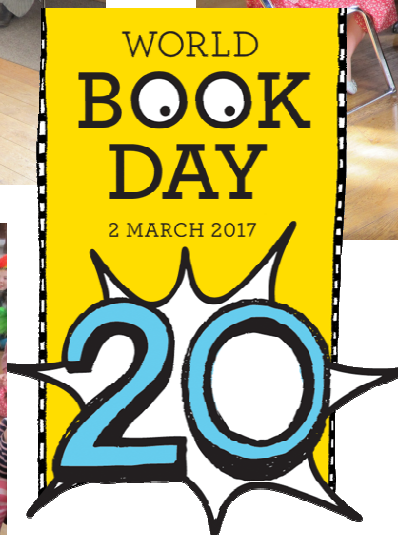


Well done children, you are a credit to Horsley School!
