Dear Parents/Carers

This term, we embark on a magical journey along the River Severn and investigate the waterways of Gloucestershire. As part of this exploration of the water cycle, rivers and coastal areas, we are venturing to the National Waterways Museum, and its docklands, in Gloucester.

During our visit to the museum, we will learn more about the River Severn and the canal system of Gloucestershire. We will also participate in a workshop, tailored to our learning, about the river systems, led by one of the museum's curators.

Following a lunch pit stop, we intend to walk the short distance to the docklands to investigate human and physical features, before returning to school full of water and river facts! The trip will take place within the normal school day on Tuesday, 31<sup>st</sup> January 2023.

Please drop your child off at the normal time for the beginning of the school day and collect as usual at 3.15pm. Each child will need to bring a packed lunch, water bottle and raincoat for the visit. We will wear school uniforms as part of the trip.

The trip requires a donation of £14.00 per child to cover its costs. We cannot afford to run it without your support. Please make payment and give permission via Parentpay, by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> January. Any financial contribution will be entirely voluntary, and your child will not be denied a place on the visit should you be unable to pay the contribution.
