Dear Parents and Carers,

We wanted to let you know about a couple of exciting changes coming up after the Easter break.

Firstly, Mrs Freeman, who many of you know as the friendly face running our Breakfast and After School Clubs, will be retiring. We are so grateful for all the care, dedication, and smiles she has given our children over the years; she will be very much missed!

We also have some exciting news! From September, we will be welcoming a fantastic new Wraparound Care provider. We can't wait to tell you all about it - it's going to be a wonderful experience for the children, with lots of fun and engaging activities.

In the meantime, Wraparound Care will look a little different, for the Summer term:

- Breakfast Club will run from 8:00am, hosted at the school by our staff, and will include a simple breakfast snack to start the day. The cost of this will be reduced to £4.75.
- After School Club will continue until 4:15pm from Monday to Friday, taking the form of fun clubs run by school staff

We know these temporary changes may cause some challenges for families, and we truly appreciate your understanding. Thank you for your patience, we promise that by September, our full wrap-around care offer will return, bigger, better, and even more exciting!

Secondly, we are delighted to share that Miss Mansell will be going on maternity leave after the Easter break - we are so excited for her! We have arranged cover in her class to ensure continuity, so the children will continue to feel safe, happy, and supported while she is away.

Thirdly, our 'long-lost' Headteacher, Mr Price, will be returning after Easter, in his full capacity! Mr Feldon will resume his role as Assistant Headteacher, while Mrs Everett will continue as SENDCo. On Thursdays, Mr Price will be supporting other schools; on these days, Mrs Everett will be 'stepping up' as Assistant Headteacher (as it is Mr Feldon's day off).

Thank you so much for your continued support as we make these transitions. We can't wait to share all the wonderful things planned for the children in the coming months and into the new school year.
