Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your patience and understanding while we have been reviewing our wraparound care provision for next term. We fully recognise that these arrangements are important for families, and we appreciate that any uncertainty can be challenging.

We have been working carefully to ensure that what we offer is both reliable for parents and sustainable for staff.

We are pleased to confirm that **for next term only**, we will be able to offer:

- **Breakfast Club every morning from 8:00am** (charged proportionately)
- **Afterschool provision until 4:15pm**

These sessions will be based in school and will provide a relaxed, welcoming environment for the children. On some days, there may be a more active, sports-focused element, giving children the opportunity to spend time outdoors and stay active. Children attending will be offered a simple snack and a drink during the session.

Please note that this is a temporary arrangement for next term, and we fully expect to return to our usual wraparound provision from September. Bookings can be made as normal, on Parentpay (if you are booking any Breakfast Club sessions before Easter, please note that you will need to make a choice between the current 7.45am start, and the 8.00am start after Easter).

While we know this may not fully meet everyone's needs, we hope that this consistent offer will provide some support for families. We will continue to review our provision as staffing allows.

In terms of other clubs available, we are really pleased that Richard will be continuing with Judo on Tuesdays in church (book directly on 07976 572203), Curious Kids will be back on Wednesdays (see latest newsletter - coming out on Friday), and Mrs Barr's Art Clubs will continue on Mondays and Wednesdays (again book directly with her on 07719440450).
